



2022 West End Photo Open Information for Photographic Artists

Submission deadline:

August 12, 2022 at midnight PDT

CCMA: The Chaffey Community Museum of Art is a fine arts museum serving the Pomona Valley (the west end region of San Bernardino County and the eastern communities of Los Angeles County).

WEPO: The museum is seeking artists for its second biennial juried photography exhibition, to be displayed in the Main Gallery from September 8 to November 12, 2022. Approximately 40 works of art will be selected by juror Douglas McCulloh, Senior Curator for UCR ARTS (www.douglasmcculloh.com)

AWARDS: From the entries, the juror will select the WEPO 2022 award (\$500) and up to four WEPO 2022 select awards (\$250 each). Prize winners will be invited to exhibit in the second biennial West End Photo Invitation (WEPI) in the fall of 2023.

ENTRY FEES: \$20 for CCMA members; \$40 for non-members. All entry fees will be retained by CCMA whether or not artwork is selected. Visit www.chaffeymuseum.org for information on joining CCMA.

TO ENTER: Submit up to three artworks in JPEG format using ArtCall (www.chaffeymuseum.org/wepo-2022/). Submission does not guarantee acceptance. Artwork over 48 inches wide will not be considered. A diptych is considered two artworks; a triptych is considered three artworks. ***The submission deadline is Friday, August 12, 2022 at midnight PDT.***

ACCEPTANCE: Artists will be notified of acceptance no later than August 18, 2022. Up to three works of art may be accepted per artist. Artwork must be photographic originals created during the period of August 2019 through August 2022, and not previously exhibited at CCMA. Artwork must be hand-delivered to CCMA, 217 S. Lemon Ave., Ontario, CA on either Saturday, September 3 or Sunday, September 4 between 10 am and 3 pm. Artists must provide a completed Lenders Agreement and ID tags with delivery.

ARTWORK SPECIFICATIONS: Artwork must not exceed 48” in width. Artwork must be wired and ready for installation. Sawtooth hangers or eye screws are not permitted. Unframed artwork intended to be push-pinned to the wall is allowed. Pedestals will be provided to display three-dimensional work. Photo-hybrid sculpture must have appropriate bases for pedestal display and not exceed 40 lbs. or be larger than 48” in any direction.

ARTWORK REJECTION: Artwork delivered for exhibition will not be accepted if not properly wired, not dry, exceeds maximum dimensions or is not ready for display. Video and projected works will not be accepted.

RUN OF EXHIBIT AND ARTIST RECEPTION: The exhibit will be on view from September 8 through November 12, 2022. Award winners will be announced at the artist reception on Sunday, October 2 from 2 pm to 4 pm. Award winners will be invited to participate in the 2023 West End Photo Invitational (WEPI), to be held in fall, 2023.

VISITING CCMA: The museum is located in the Ontario Arts District, 217 S. Lemon Ave., Ontario. Public hours are noon to 4 pm Thursday through Sunday. Admission and parking are free. The Ontario Museum of History & Art is located directly across Lemon Avenue from CCMA and its public hours match CCMA's.
